The regular monthly meeting of the Executive Committee of the Libertarian Party of Georgia was held virtually on Monday, September 8, 2025, at 7:00 PM.

### Reports

Reports were given by Acting Chairman Brian Allen, Secretary Sergio Ortega, and Assistant Treasurer Mark Mosley.

### Director Applications

The Secretary reported the applications for Convention Director. Sergio Ortega nominated Alan Hill for the position, which was accepted. Nominations were then closed. By show of hands, Alan Hill was elected to be Convention Director.

Nominations were opened for Bylaws Director. Kyle Davis nominated Sergio Ortega for the position, which he refused the nomination. Sergio Ortega nominated Amber Howell for the position, which was accepted. Nominations were then closed. By show of hands, Amber Howell was elected to be Bylaws Director.

Nominations were opened for Membership Director. Sergio Ortega nominated Katie Gordon for the position, which was accepted. Nominations were then closed. By show of hands, Katie Gordon was elected to be Membership Director.

### Endorsement of Kerry Hatcher for Bibb County School Board

Mr. Kerry Hatcher gave a speech for five minutes on their potential endorsement.

Brian Allen moved to endorse Mr. Kerry Hatcher for Bibb County School Board Post 7, which was seconded by Sergio Ortega. The motion passed with a two-thirds vote in favor.

#### Amending the 2026 Budget for the Executive Director Salary

Sergio Ortega moved to amend the 2026 LP Georgia Annual Budget for the Executive Director salary item to be \$1,390, which was seconded by Daniel Fleck. The motion failed.

#### Amending the 2026 Budget to Extend Funding into January 2027

Sergio Ortega moved to amend the 2026 LP Georgia Annual Budget to include equal funding for January 2027 as allocated in December 2026 in the 2026 LP Georgia Monthly Budget, which was seconded by Daniel Fleck. The motion failed.

#### Discussion on LNC Regional Representative Attempted Removal

Discussion was had on removal proceedings against Jonathan McGee, Representative of Region 2 to the Libertarian National Committee.

Sergio Ortega moved to direct the Chair or Acting Chair to only vote in favor of appointing Mr. Jonathan McGee to be LNC Region 2 Representative for the current term in any ballot to fill a vacancy stemming from the alleged removal, which was seconded by Kyle Davis. The motion was adopted.

#### Discussion on National Bylaws

Discussion was had on National Bylaws in light of the upcoming 2026 Libertarian National Convention in Grand Rapids, Michigan.
